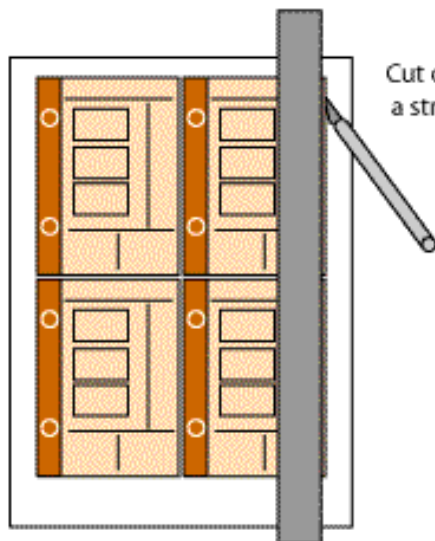


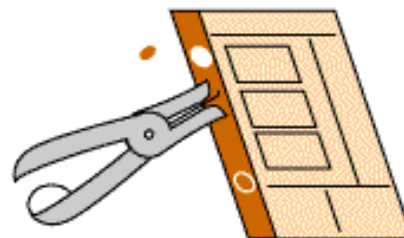
Assembling the ἩΠΛΟΜΑΧΙΑ Sanides (san-EE-thez)

The Sanides are meant to simulate the wood and wax writing tablets of the time. here's how to make them

Print the Unit cards files (CD1- 10) and the four Sanides files (HopSanA-D) on as heavy card stock as your printer allows.

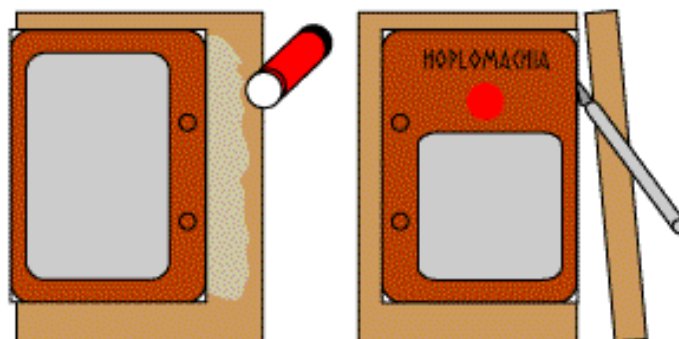
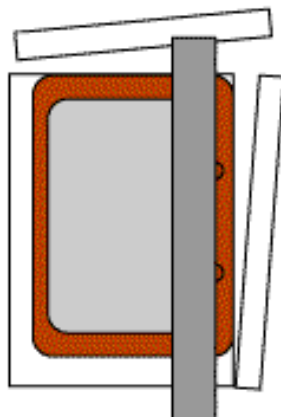


Cut out the unit Cards with a sharp knife (carefull!) and a straight edge metal ruler.



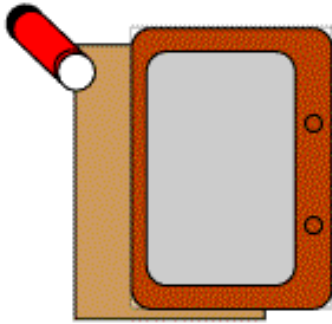
Punch holes out where you see the little circles on the side pattern.

Cut out hopSan A-D.
Cut along the straight outside edges.
Leave the corners on for now.

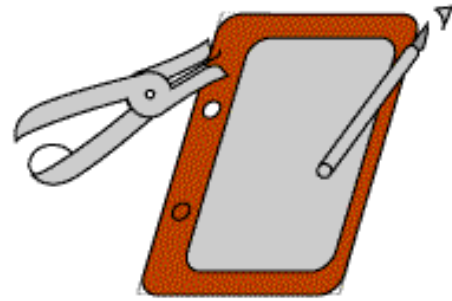
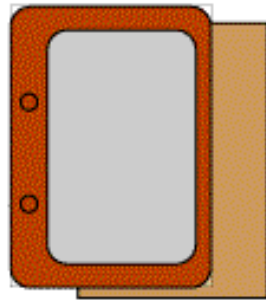


Glue only the Sanides A and D each to it's own piece of cardboard. (Stay away from flimsy corrugated cardboard)
Then cut the extra cardboard away.

Once dry, glue B to the other side of A...



...and C to the other side of D.



Then cut the corners round and punch or cut the holes out.

Finally choose out the unit cards that you plan to use for a battle, and place them between the two Sanides. Tie them together with a leather thong, or a shoelace, or some old twine, or whatever you like. Make sure that the whole assembly is tied loosely enough to let it all lie flat when open. Strike up the Paean...it's time to make WAR!
